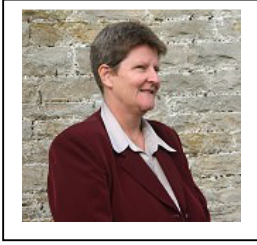

RÉSUMÉ

Clare Garside has practised as an Occupational Therapy Expert Witness since 1984 and is a founding director of Assessability Limited. In addition to her extensive experience she has undertaken formal Expert Witness training in report writing and giving evidence in court. She holds Professional Indemnity insurance to the value of six million pounds. Assessability is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office, ICO reference: Z719546X.

She prepares reports to inform litigation on the instruction of the claimant (average 70%) or defendant (average 20%) or as a single joint expert (average 10%). She prepares some 15 assessment reports a year. She has extensive experience of preparing Joint Statements and appears in court to give expert testimony as required.

Clare Garside's expertise typically contributes in the following types of cases:
